Dancing Rules

- 1. This competition is governed by RSOBHD and ScotDance USA rules.
- All dancers must be registered with ScotDance USA, or another RSOBHD approved registration body in order to dance. Registration Number must be on Entry Form.
 Registration is contingent on your 2024 RSOBHD dancer registration number. If entering with a 2023 Registration number please inform the committee of your new
- number before February 24, 2024 by contacting: Diane Krugh at the following email: NationalRegistrar@scotdanceusa.com
- 4. Dancer registration card must be produced on the day of the event in order to compete.
- 5. Age groups will be finalized after entries are received.
- 6. Dancer age will be determined as of Friday March 8th, 2024.
- 7. Pre-premier dancers will have the ability to earn one stamp on their registration card over the two-day event.
- 8. Organizer reserves the right to split or combine classes the day of the competition.
- 9. Dancers who are last to enter will be first to dance, and when applicable the dancer will fill in for the ½ Tulloch.
- 10. The organizer reserves the right to make changes to any information given in the entry form if necessary.
- 11. Communication by a dancer or parent of a dancer with the judge or piper is not allowed and is grounds for disqualification.
- 12. Pre-Premier category changes must be made by March 1, 2024. To make a pre-premier category change please contact Diane Krugh at the following email: NationalRegistrar@scotdanceusa.com
- 13. Dancers not on hand when their class is called will forfeit entry on that event.
- 14. All winners must be in competition dress to accept awards.
- 15. All dance competitors and teachers are expected to comply with the RSOBHD & SDUSA Code of Ethics.
- 16. Entry fee includes dancer admission to the venue.
- 17. Entries must be SUBMITTED by February 24, 2024. Late entries will be accepted with DOUBLE FEES after February 24. 2024.
- 18. No field entries will be accepted.
- 19. All Entry fees and other related payments are non-refundable.
- 20. Judge's decision is final. Any protest must be in writing, signed, and handed to the Dance Director by the end of the competition, accompanied by a fee of \$30.00 that would be refundable if the protest is sustained.
- 21. **3 Month Rule:** Judges who conduct teaching or coaching classes, seminars or any other forms of tuition (e.g. by video conferencing), may not adjudicate any competitor who has attended any of these classes, for a period of three months after the last class, workshop or any other form of tuition that competitor has attended.
- 22. **Premier Challenge:** Each dance in the Premier Challenge will be judged by an individual judge. The overall scholarship placings for the Premier Challenge will be awarded based on the accumulated points from each of the three dances individual judge's placings. Each judge's top 6 winners in each dance will be announced on stage. Dancers who receive a top 6 placing in a dance but not an overall scholarship will receive a recognition medal.

23. Traditional Broadsword:

- a. Premier dancers only.
- b. Initial registration will be limited to the first 12 entries. If you are unable to register, please contact Diane Krugh, National Registrar, via email (nationalregistrar@ scotdanceusa.com) and request to be added to the waitlist. Additional entries may be accepted from the waitlist at the discretion of the organizer. If, after entering, circumstances prevent your team from participating, please contact Diane Krugh, National Registrar, via email (nationalregitrar@ scotdanceusa.com) as soon as possible so another team from the waitlist can be added to the event. Music to be used: Donald MacPhee Definitive Collection Track 71- Broadsword 3&1.
- c. The traditional Broadswords dance is a sword dance performed by four people wearing traditional Highland Dress, round and over four Highland Broadswords placed tip to tip in the form of a cross. The dance consists of a number of steps in Strathspey tempo, followed by steps in Reel tempo, the steps to be based on Highland technique. In view of its military connections with the Scottish regiments the dance may be preceded and completed by a short march and salute.
- d. Schools can enter more than one team, however a dancer is restricted to dancing in a maximum of 2 teams.
- e. Broadsword Teams should consist of: a) One school only OR b) More than one school, in which case, the teacher/choreographer must abide by the three month teaching/judging rule.
- f. Broadsword teams comprised of two or more schools must fill out the Joint School Choreography Team Form.
- g. Broadsword will be judged by a panel of 3 judges and scrutineered per championship scoring methods.
